Directed international research for Stripe Terminal in Japan, managing vendor selection and identifying target merchants for interviews in partnership with Shopify. Conducted in-country research that provided valuable insights into local market dynamics, device needs, expectations, and merchant experiences that will unlock an estimated \$5 billion in new revenue by 2027.

Spearheaded research with data science that identified the opportunity for automated hardware returns, resulting in a 75% reduction in warranty processing support cases, a 31% decrease in customer contact rates, and approximately \$0.5 million in savings.

Conducted in-depth analysis of leading platforms and enterprise requirements for the next generation of Terminal devices, focusing on innovative form factors including screen sizes, docking solutions, and mobile versus countertop applications.

Executed surveys and PSAT measurements that target Stripe Terminal's top platforms and partners, gathering valuable insights that drove the development of new device hardware tailored to specific geographies and vertical markets in addition to improving product quality.

Led research initiatives for Stripe Apps, guiding the team with key insights that culminated in the successful launch of the Stripe App Marketplace in June 2022, now utilized by over 16,000 merchants monthly, featuring 87 public apps and 300 private apps that streamline and automate various business processes on the Stripe platform.

Created the role of researcher for the Venmo team, I developed and established the user research program from the ground up, managing testing pipelines in collaboration with product managers, analytics, and design partners.
